




People take action because they're passionate. They want to make a positive change. However, there is a risk that an action can be misinformed, badly timed, and potentially cause harm.

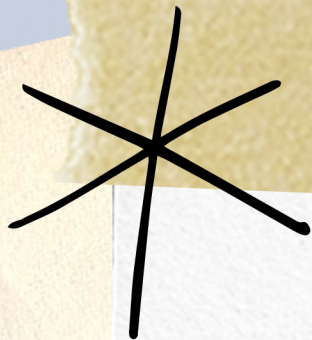
Do I have all the facts I need? Are they from multiple sources?

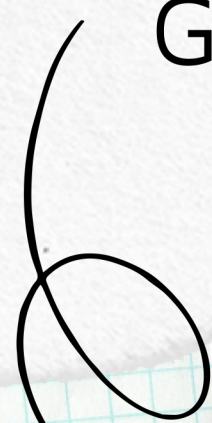

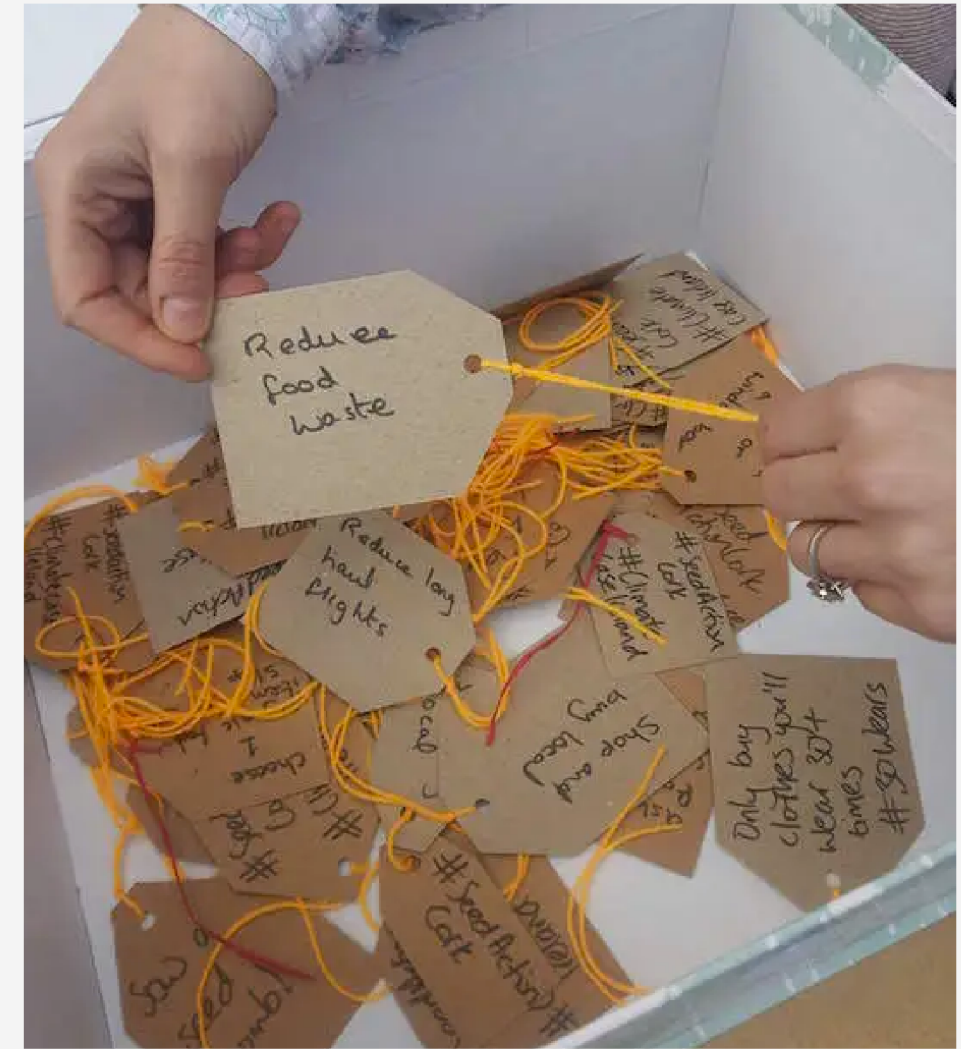

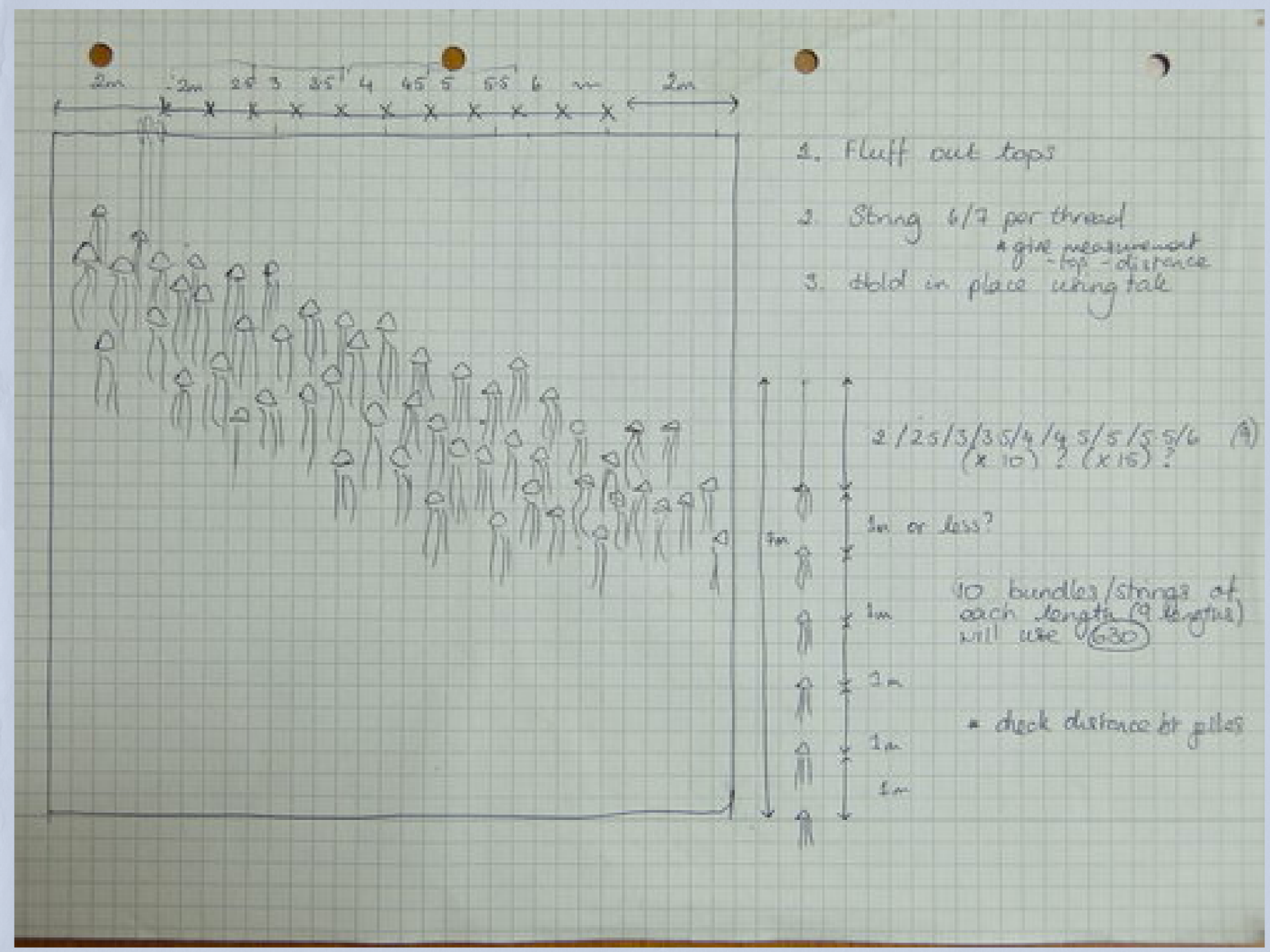
